task of picking the top four bands that are moving on to the finals on July 4th at the Tacoma Freedom Fair. They also picked the winner of Solo/Duo competition. The judges were Ernest Jasmin (Staff Writer, Tacoma Weekly), Rick Jacobsen (drummer of Wired! Band) and Ron Swarner (Owner-Editor, Weekly Volcano). I also would like to thank all our volunteers who helped during the event. We couldn't have done it without you!

In the Solo/Duo act category, blues and boogie-woogie pianist Arthur Migliazza took top honors and will therefore be representing the South Sound Blues Association in Memphis next January, at the International Blues Challenge. In the Band category, Palmer Jct, The Crazy Texas Gypsies, The Cody Rentas Band and The Randy Oxford Band are moving on to the finals on July 4th. This is a fantastic lineup of talent, so plan on arriving early and finding a good spot at the Duke's Chowder House Blues Stage and Beer Garden. 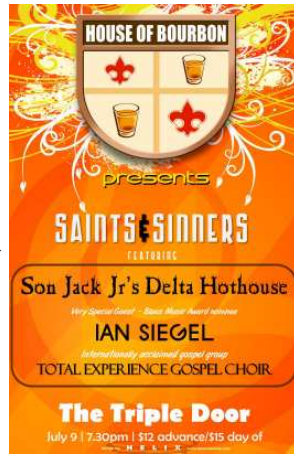
Now, as for the **new music project**, by the time you read this we should have released our first EP and announced details on the new band and most importantly, the new music direction. Stay tuned!

Nolan Garrett - First CD Release!

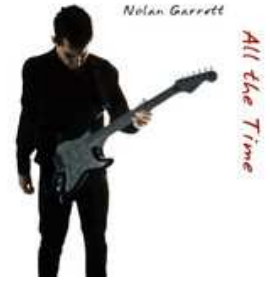

Featuring 11 original tracks written or co-written by Garrett, "**All the Time**" was produced in Los Angeles by Jeff Kossack of Other Hand Recording. Garrett, who was staying at the famed Sunset Marquis hotel during the weekend of 2012's Grammy Awards, was practicing his guitar poolside when he was approached by Kossack and the legendary Cyndi Lauper,



who was particularly intrigued by his playing.

"I was just sitting there working on my practice routines in my own little space," Garrett recalled. "I did that for about eight hours. I didn't know who (Lauper) was when she first came up, and she said, 'You've been playing that guitar all day. Have you finally learned to play a song?'" Garrett then played his song "Don't Criticize Me" (which he included on "All the Time") for Lauper and Kossack and things took off from there. Garrett returned to L.A. five times to record "All the Time" with Kossack.



"It's so professional down there. It was a real learning experience," Garrett said, and the same held true during shooting of his soon-to-be-released music video for "Don't Criticize Me" created by Robot Sound, Cannon Boys and Robot Film Company in LA.

The variety of music on "All the Time" reveals just how diverse and talented this straight-A School of the Arts (SOTA) student is. A mixture of funk, blues, rock and slow songs, the CD includes an eclectic blend of musical genres, which has become Garrett's trademark. His biggest influences include Jimi Hendrix, Paul McCartney and John Mayer, and his music reflects elements of each of these artists' styles coupled with his own twist and flair. "People say, 'he's in all these genres,' but I just twist what I feel," Garrett said.

While songs like "Don't Criticize Me" give the CD a certain amount of bluesy swagger, it's Garrett's slower songs that bring out his heart and soul in the most wonderful ways. His voice sounds youthful and vulnerable when he sings the slow stuff, and when he's singing harder/funkier tunes his voice takes on a harder and more forceful tone that perfectly suits the music.

The lyrics to his music also matter, as the words reflect the young man's life experiences that he shares with listeners. For example, on the title track he sings a chorus to just be yourself: "My picture ain't perfect in your mind/ and neither are you and that's all right/ I wouldn't even start to try/ just worry about living your life/ through all this I hope you see/ no one should tell you how to be/ I wouldn't even start to try/ we don't gotta be perfect all the time."

In April, Garrett performed at the celebrated Whiskey A Go-Go in West Hollywood and has been invited back for a second show on June 22. Here in Tacoma, be sure to catch him next month at the Old Town Blues Festival on July 13 and Art on the Ave on July 14.

Blues Hall of Famer Bobby Blue Bland Passes

Robert Calvin Bland was born in Rosemark, Tennessee in 1930. He still lives in Germantown today. He universally acknowledged as the greatest male blues singer in history. Fans can argue all day about the best guitarist or best bluesman but there is no real argument about the best male blues singer. It is Bobby "Blue" Bland.

In the early '50s, he began hanging around Beale Street with the likes of Johnny Ace, Roscoe Gordon, Earl Forrest and B.B. King. They became known as the Beale Streeters. He made recordings as early as 1950-52, but he had not yet found his style. In 1952, he was drafted and served in the Army for two and a half years.

From 1957 into 1962, he delivered national hits like "Further Up the Road," "I Pity the Fool," "Two Steps From the Blues," "Turn on Your Love Light," "Yield Not to Temptation" and "Stormy Monday Blues," to name just a few of the most memorable. He continued to record into the '90s and scored a major hit in 1985 with "Members Only." Many of these hits sold half a million to a million copies.
