Six top regional acts will be featured. Performing in order of appearance are, The Rafael Tranquilino Band, Blues County Sheriff, Blenis/Ehly Band with Special Guest Thai Barker, **Arthur Migliazza**, The Mark Riley Trio and **The Randy Oxford Band.**

THE RANDY OXFORD BAND (Band Category) and **ARTHUR MIGLIAZZA** (Solo Duo Act Category) won this year’s regional competition, and will be representing the South Sound Blues Association at the International Blues Challenge in Memphis, January 21-25, 2014. The International Blues Challenge in Memphis is the largest gathering of blues artists in the world. Groups from around the globe are chosen to represent their states and countries. Musician Profile: Arthur Migliazza

On June 2nd, Arthur Migliazza won the Solo/Duo category competition for the SSBA's "Back To Beale Street" event. He will compete beginning January 21st in Memphis, TN. The SSBA will be putting on two fundraisers, both for Arthur and for the Band category winner, The Randy Oxford Band. These events are at The Swiss (Sep. 29th) and Jazzbones (Nov. 3rd).

The first time I saw Arthur, he was walking across the commons lawn at Ft. Worden, wearing a parka and stocking cap (while I wore t-shirt and shorts), hunching his way through the Summer Pt. Townsend mist. He was living in Arizona at that time, and this was his first time on the faculty of the annual Acoustic Blues Workshop. And as was obvious from his discomfort, his first time in sometimes chilly Pt. Townsend.

In the beginning of the week, those of us in his class quickly realized Arthur's natural playing and teaching skills. In only days he had us playing slow blues, boogie woogie, and New Orleans-style piano. By the end of that week we had also recognized his natural human qualities. Arthur exudes warmth and a genuine desire to improve the skills of anyone he is teaching at a given moment. At the end of that week we were treated to a blow-out performance at the Upstage that brought audience members to their feet. His original "Boogie Woogie Man," segues into a boogie version of Flight of the Bumblebee and quotes of other classic tunes; Arthur is one of the best show closers I have witnessed.

In following years Arthur has taught me many useful piano techniques that had previously eluded me, especially in the New Orleans subgenre. He often teaches iconic riffs by starting at full speed, smoothly slowing down to an easily comprehensible tempo, and then just as smoothly bringing it back to the original. He teaches an easy to comprehend and remember "Seven Keys to Success" in New Orleans-style. Above all, he guides with patience and empathy for those of us struggling with the basics.

Arthur has studied under piano greats Henry Butler, Ann Rabson, and Mr. B. He was inducted into the Arizona Blues Hall of Fame and was a finalist at the 2010 International Blues Challenge in Memphis. He moved from Arizona to New York City, where he kept busy playing at night and giving lessons over Skype. Recently the Puget Sound area was privileged to have Arthur make his home here. He now appears locally at various venues in West Seattle, Columbia City, Tacoma and downtown Seattle. He performs solo, as well as with other talented locals, such as Del Rey, Orville Johnson and Grant Dermody. One club owner is a fan of the late James Booker, so for his show there, Arthur arranged a deep composite of tunes from Booker and other New Orleans greats Professor Longhair, Dr. John, Allen Toussaint and Fats Domino.

Check out Arthur's performance calendar at www.arthurmigliazza.com and catch one of his memorable performances over the coming months. Even better, come to the fundraisers and help send off Arthur and the Randy Oxford Band to Memphis. Arthur is coming out with a new blues and boogie woogie CD in December - "Layin' It Down," sponsored as a Kickstarter project. In January, Arthur will have another shot at the International Blues Competition, and our membership can be proud to have him representing the SSBA.

Another Beautiful Day for the Blues

After Thursday's dramatic drenching and threats of disrupting a weekend of outdoor live music, Saturday (August 31st) turned out to be confirmation that the blues gods do exist and they want our festivals to be glorious events.

My choice for the event-filled Labor Day weekend was the Third Annual Bothell Blues Festival. After an unprofitable initial project which is not uncommon, it was clear from yesterday's turnout that organizer/promoter Sean McVeigh has turned the corner by nailing down a formula for success. Sean has carved out a special space in the west end of the Country Village shopping complex in Bothell, supported by an admirable group of sponsors, adding up to what is sure to be a packed all-ages crowd well into the future.

Northenders and out of town visitors were treated to a full day of outstanding music with a top-notch lineup of local PNW favorites. Virginia transplant Eric Freeman opened the show at noon with a classic old school piedmont-style set, followed by Palmer Jct., The Stacy Jones Band and Chester Dennis Jones. The closing act was none other than the 2012 International Blues Challenge winners WIRED!

The venue setting provided plenty of sun and shade throughout the day, with a tantalizing menu served up by Eastside favorite Carolina Smoke BBQ and a roughly 100-person capacity beer garden sponsored by Floor Mechanics LLC and tended by Foggy Noggin' Brewery and Open Road Winery. Additional participants/vendors included massage treatments, delivered meals from the Village Bean restaurant, a hand-made ice cream sandwich cart and some local non-profit cause booths.

While Sean claims not to know what he is doing, it is clear that he has managed to organize an exceptionally-well run event with a highly attentive staff of volunteers wanting nothing more than to make sure everyone has a great time.

We can only hope that the event doesn't outgrow this perfect location. Future event tickets may sell out, so if you want to attend, I'd be sure to grab those tickets as soon as they go on sale. Bookmark www.bothellbluesfestival.com for future event news.

Jammin’ for Jho

For eight hours on Sunday, **September 8**, some of the best bands in the area will gather at the Swiss to pay tribute to Tacoma guitar master Jho Blenis. Jho is the consummate working musician – performing, writing songs and teaching guitar as a lifelong career. He’s been an integral part of several iconic bands over the last 30+ years, most recently Big Nasty, Bump Kitchen, Little Bill & the Bluenotes, Randy Oxford Band and the Blenis-Ehly Band.

Those who know Jho have watched him struggle with health issues in the last few years. For a while it was thought the problem was his heart, but this last year Jho was examined by doctors at the University of Washington Hospital and was finally given an irrefutable diagnosis. Jho has pulmonary fibrosis, which is not good. The condition involves the formation or development of excess fibrous [connective tissue](#) in the lungs according to Wikipedia, and in Jho’s case, it is untreatable.

Meanwhile, the man is still very busy. He has an ever-growing number of guitar students (especially adults), he’s performing regularly and is writing crazy-good songs ‘til the wee hours of the night. A CD of some of his new songs is in the works. As his long-time partner Janice says, “He’s just too ornery to slow down.”

The event on Sunday will feature all the bands listed above and then some - a testimony to the level of respect in which Jho is held by his fellow musicians. The end-of-the-evening jam should be a special one. There will also be a silent auction in the pool room and raffle drawings throughout the show. If you have an item you’d like to donate for auction or raffle, just bring it with you to the show. All proceeds benefit Jho Blenis, to help with medical expenses.
